Inside, it was time to go.

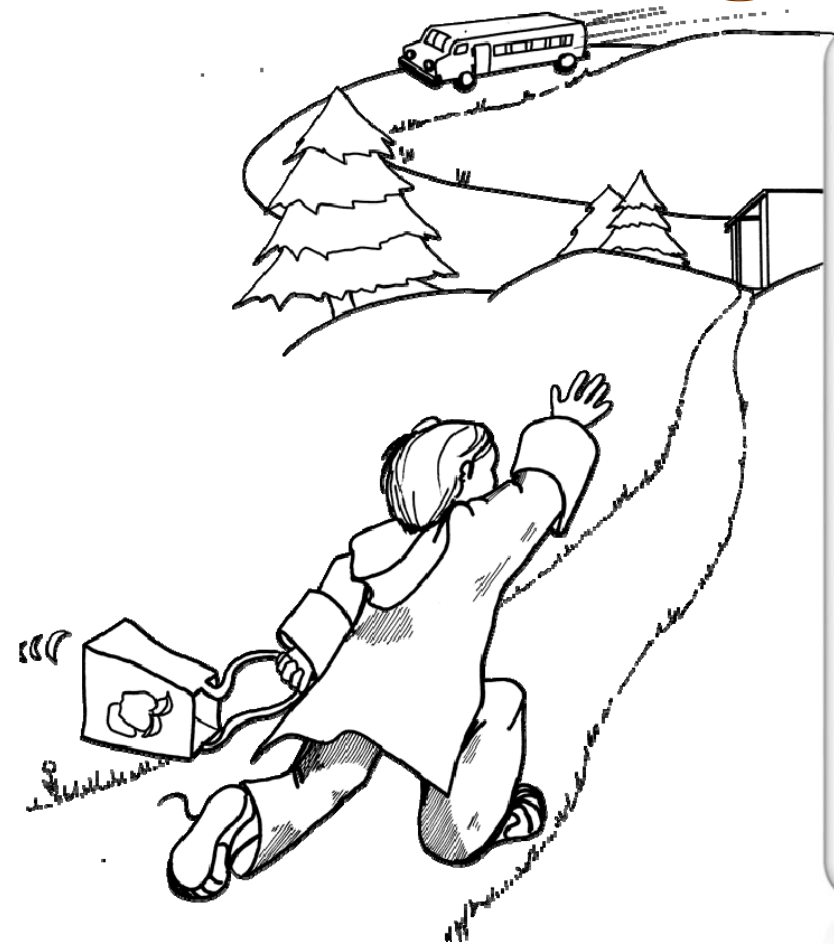

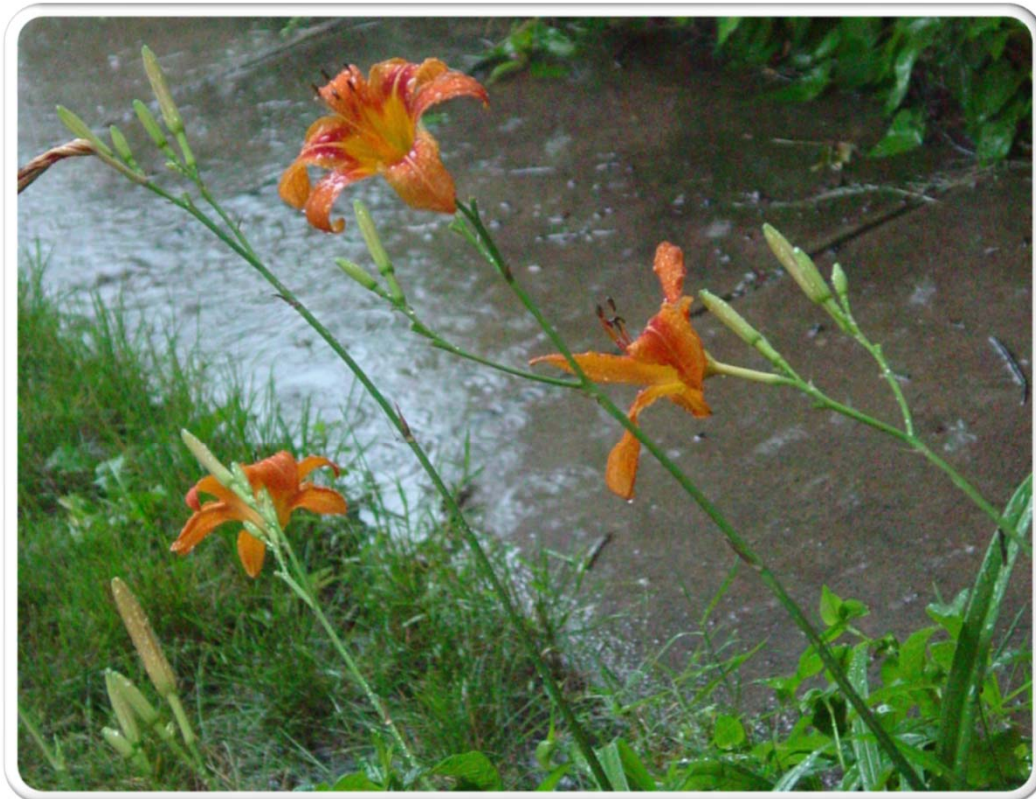

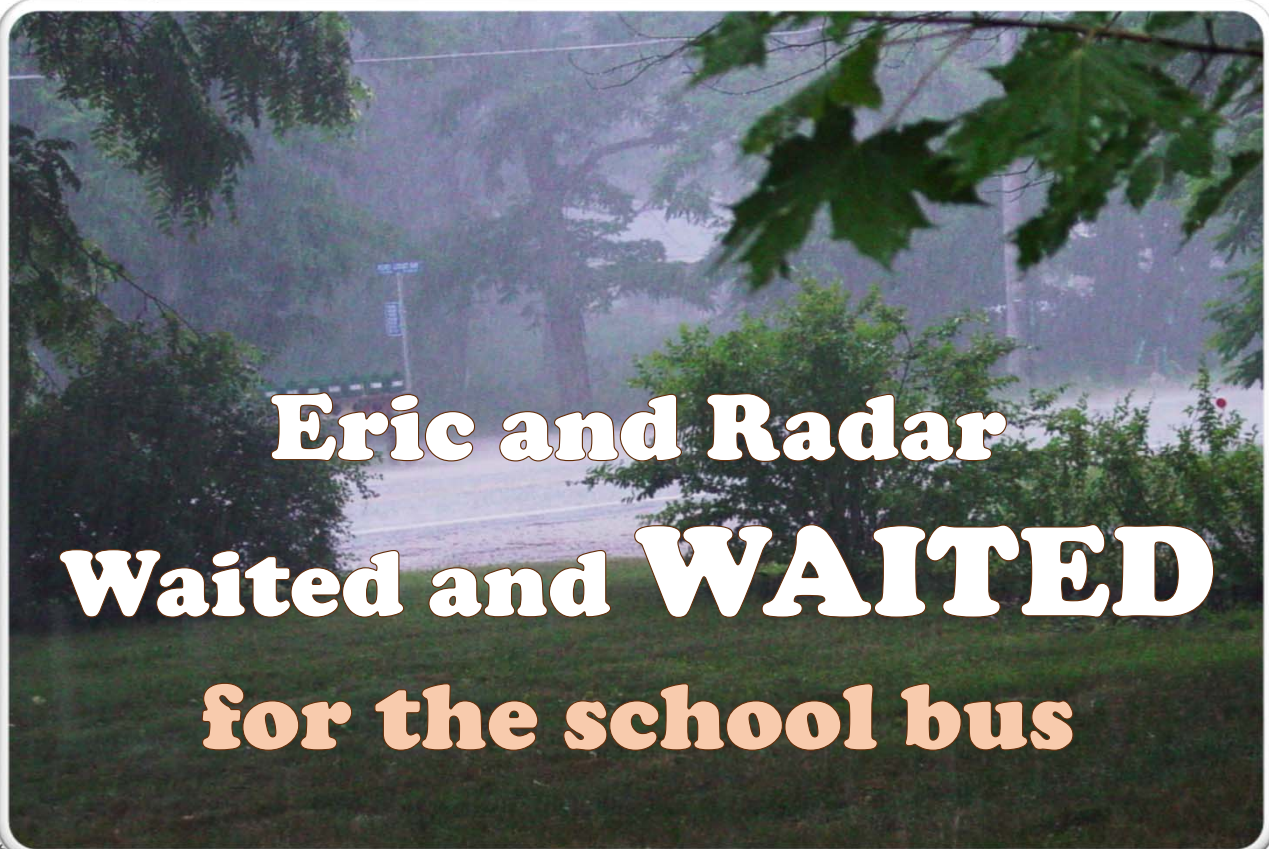
The storm blew in...

down!

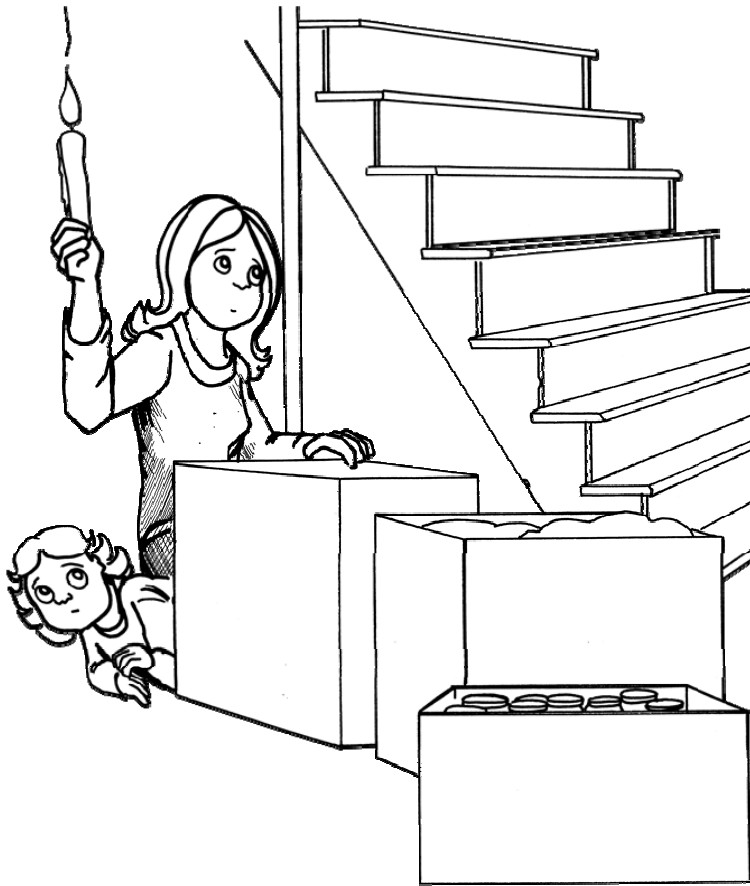


The sky grew dark!

Darker and darker!

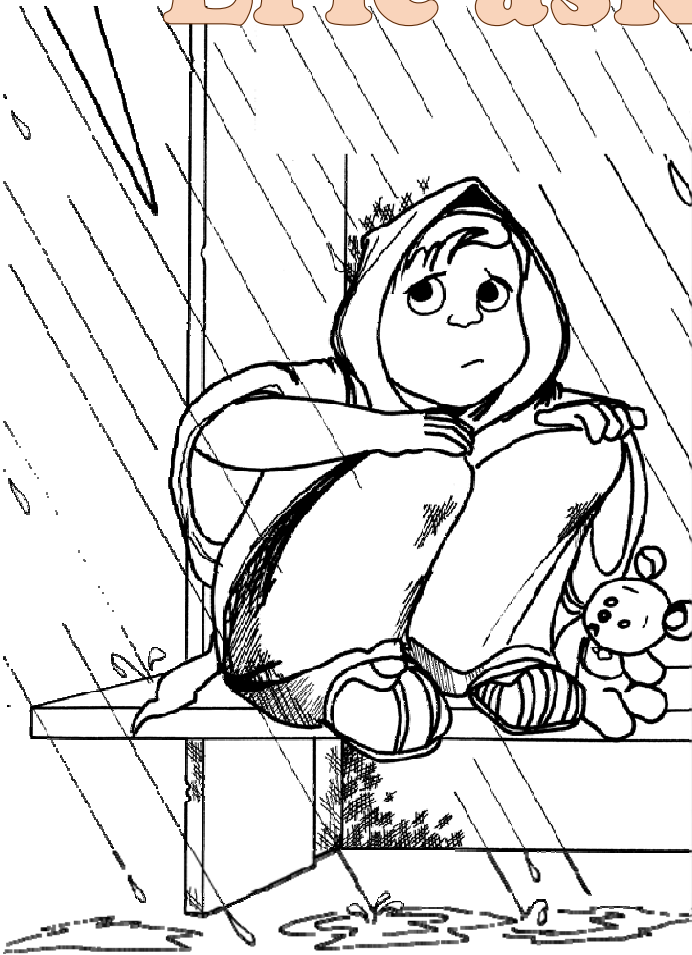


The power went out.

in the basement.**

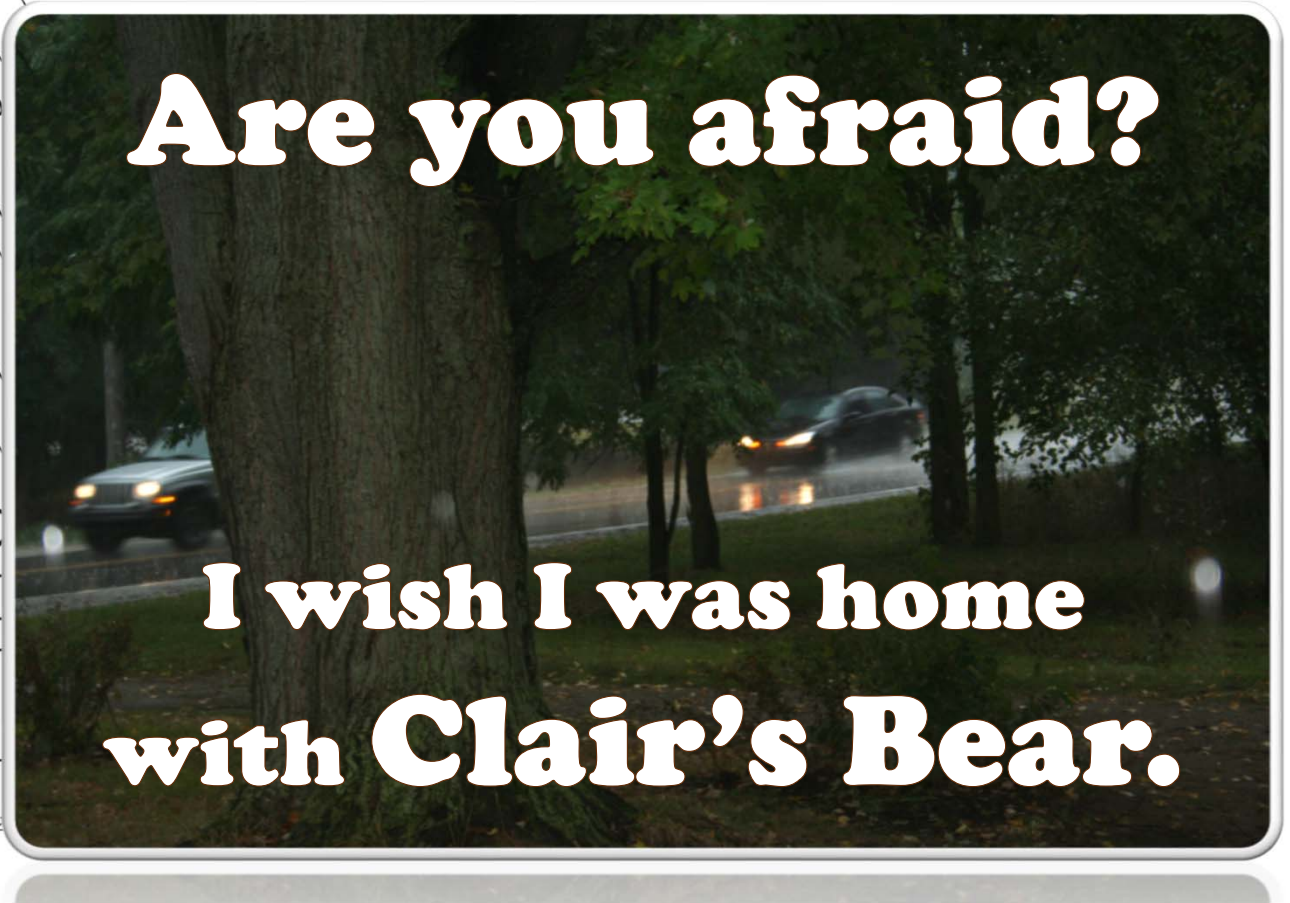


Eric asked Radar

Bear! Clair's Bear!



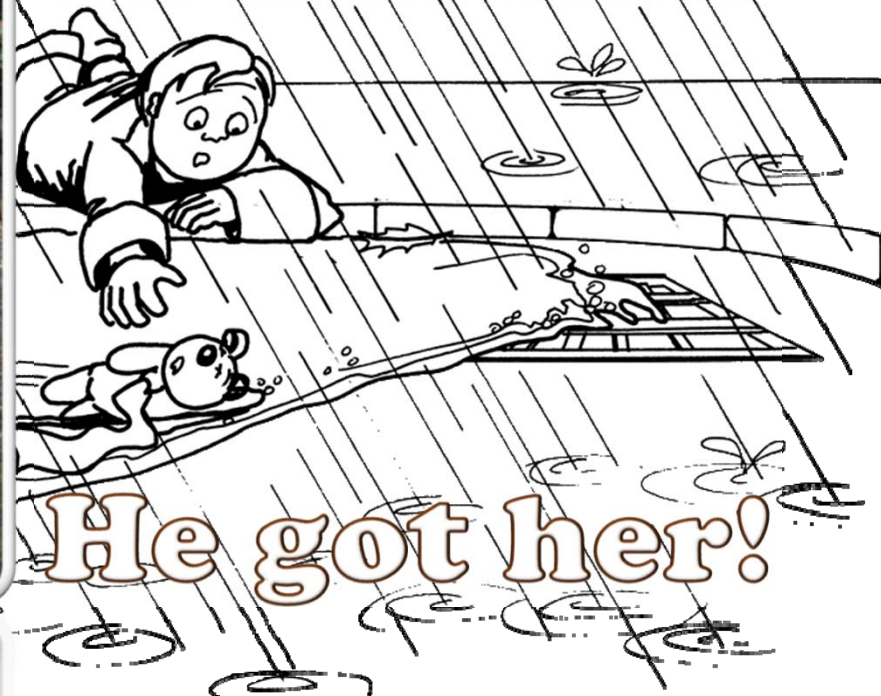
The little bear was

far as he could

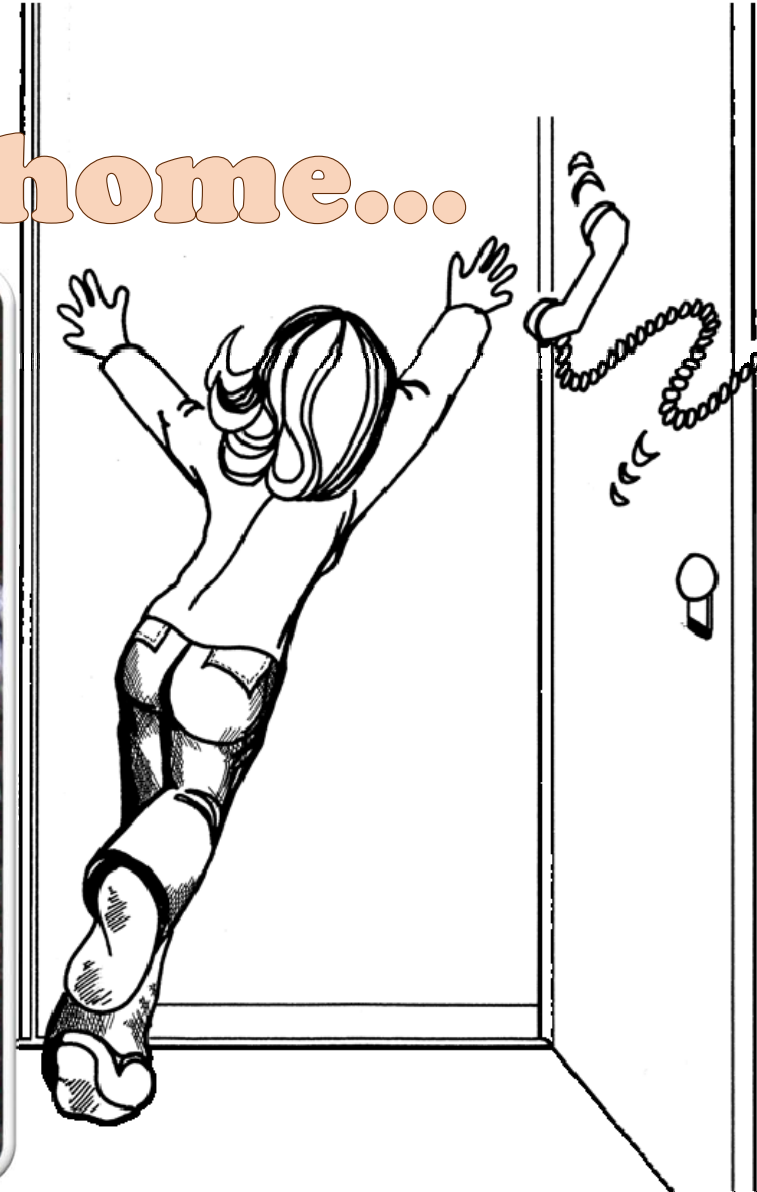
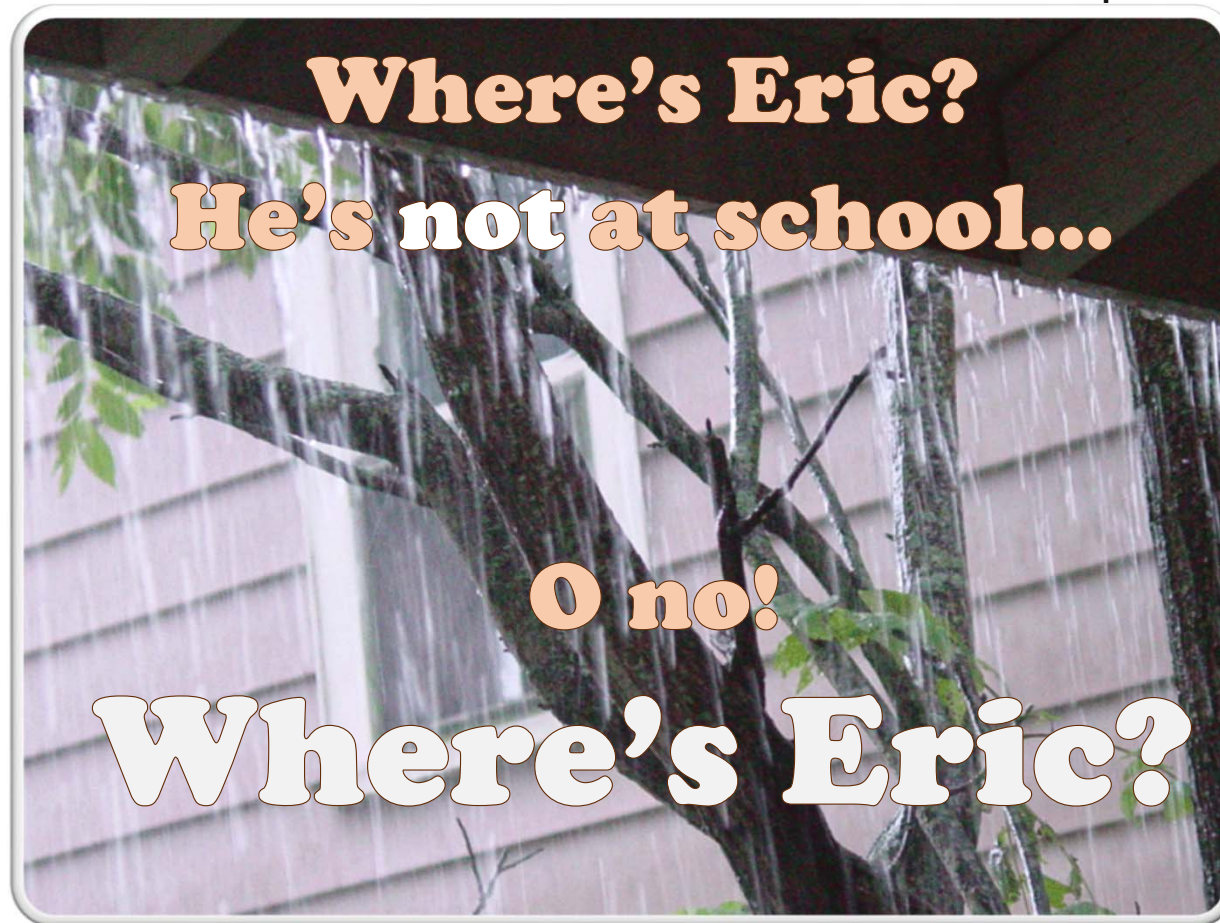


They hurried to the shelter

But, It's OK Now



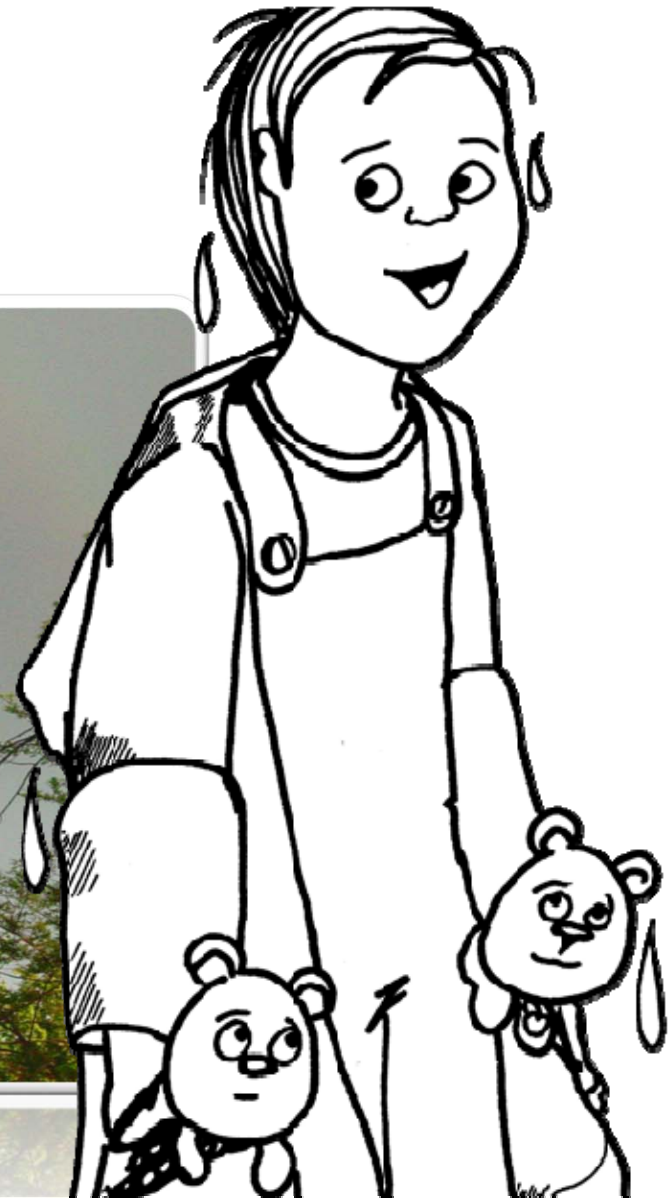
Were you afraid?

rainbow!

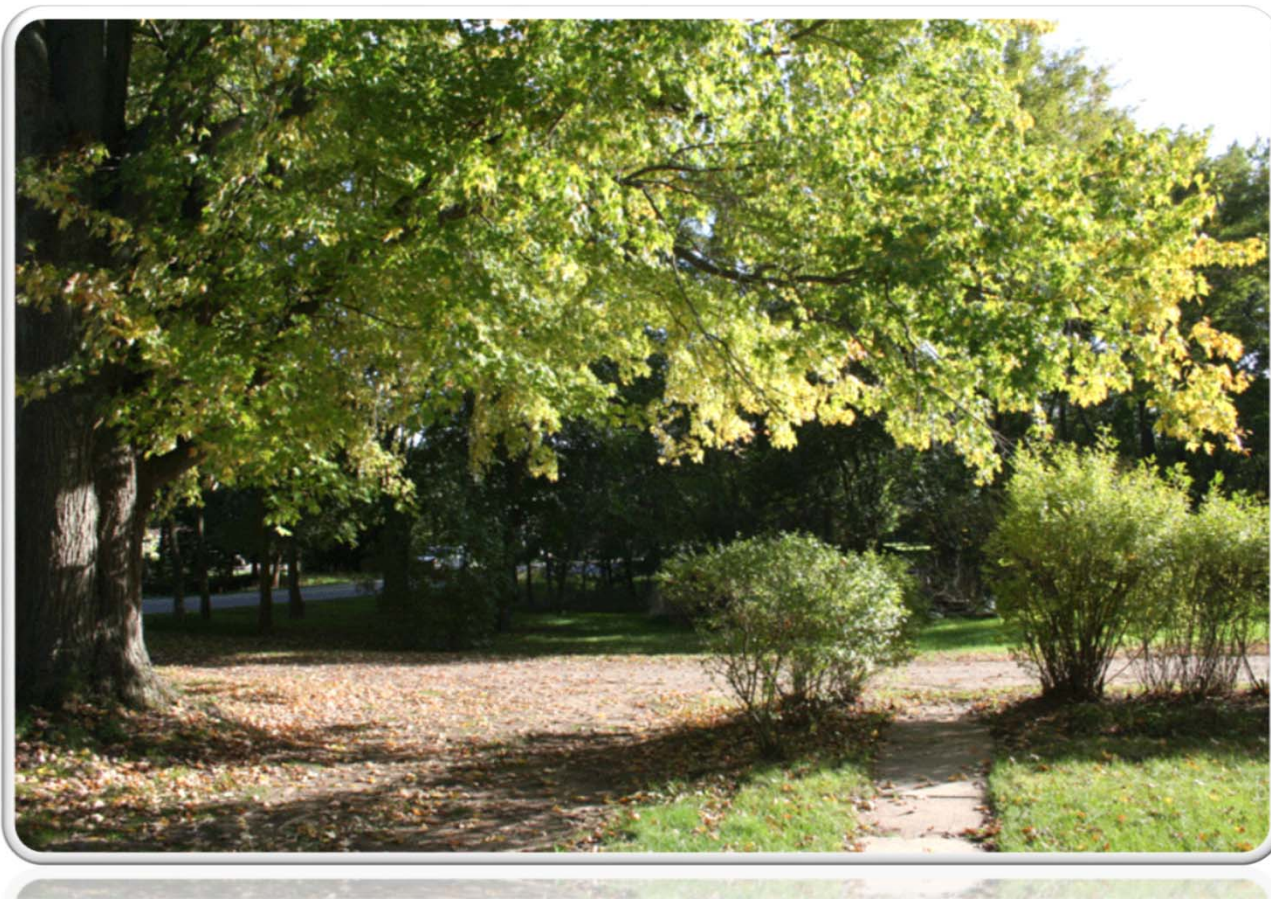


We took the Bears home

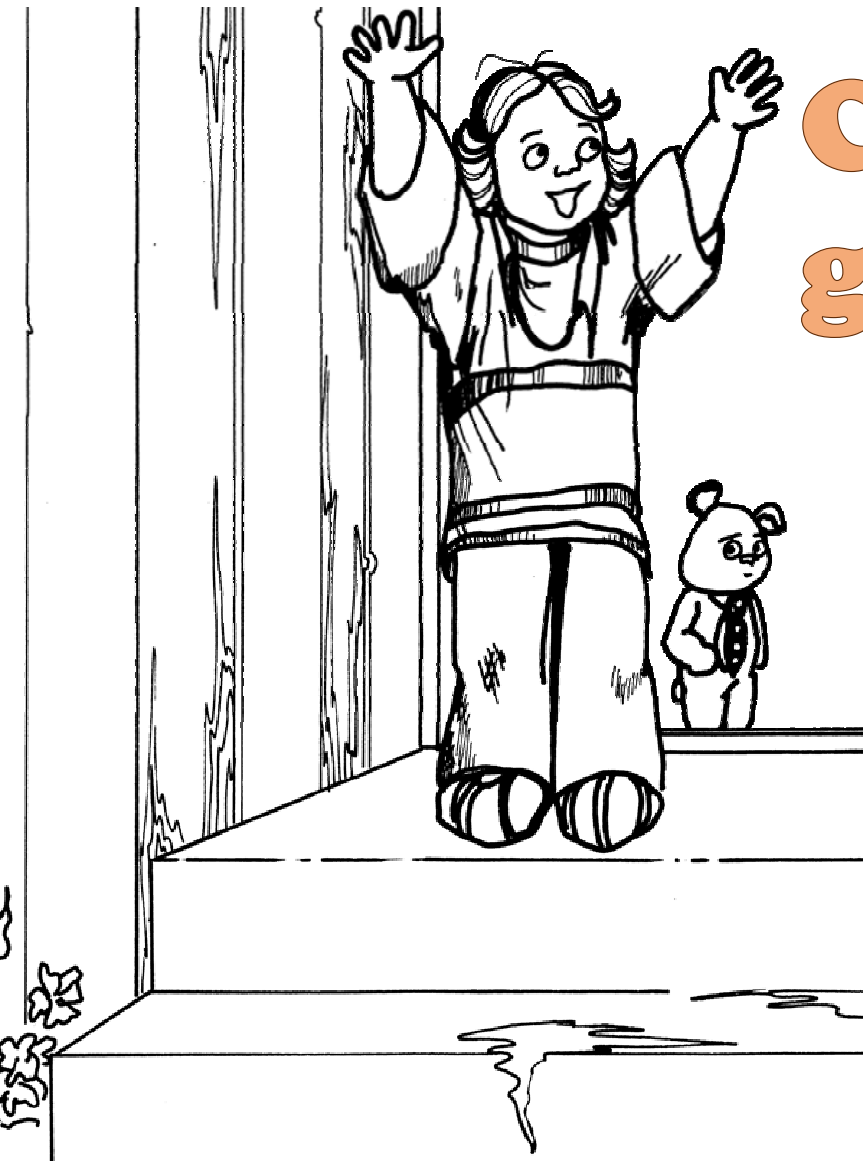


Washed them

The storm was over...



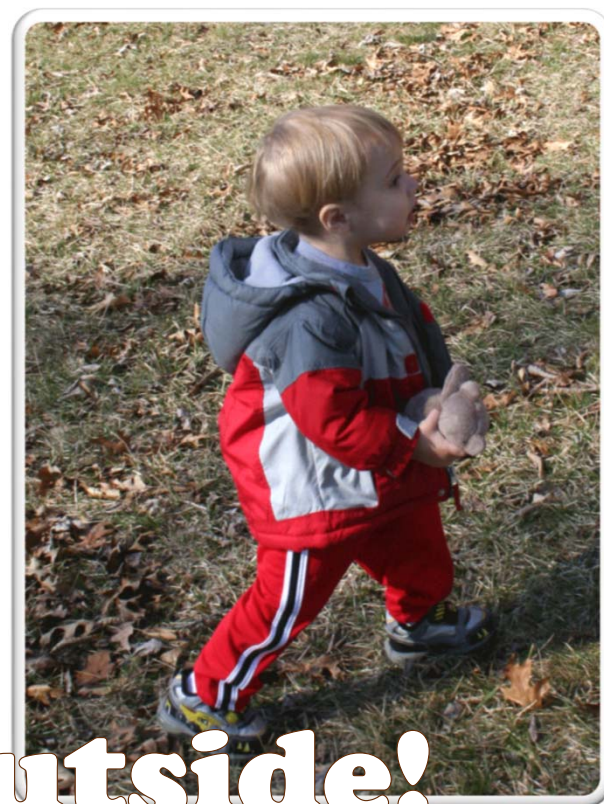
